BY CONSENT, THE COURT NOTES THAT:

- A. The first respondent concedes that:
 - (i) the second respondent failed to consider a representation made by the applicant, separate to his non-refoulement claims, that as a result of civil instability in Sudan, he faced a risk of harm upon return to that country; and
 - (ii) the failure to consider that representation was material.

BY CONSENT, THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

- A writ of certiorari issue quashing the decision of the second respondent dated 30 August 2023.
- 2. A writ of mandamus issue directed to the second respondent requiring it to determine the application made to it for review of the decision of a delegate of the first respondent dated 6 June 2023 according to law.
- 3. The first respondent pay the applicant's costs, to be taxed if not agreed.
